VIDEO PRESENTATION

GUIDELINES:

1. The video presentation contest is open to all perioperative nurses; each chapter must submit only one entry and 5 entries for NCR on first come first serve basis.
2. The video presentation must:
 - must be related to the Perioperative Nurses week theme “ORNAP as One: Fostering unity, competence and Resiliency.
 - must exhibit the sacrifices, innovation, collaboration, and best practices of perioperative nurses in this time of pandemic.
 - lastly, it will showcase the chapter’s culture, identity and other historical related activities or places that is unique to the area. This might be group performance or effort presenting any form of entertainment including dance, music, theatre or any that form of art that reflect creativity and identity.
3. A maximum of 3 mins – 5 mins (180 - 300seconds) per video. **5 points** will be deducted in every 5 seconds time exceeded.
4. Videos can be shot using any device capable of recording standard or high-definition video: ahigh-quality webcam on your computer, a hand-held video camera, or a hand-held device such assmartphone.
5. Data privacy must be strictly observed.
6. Video must be pre screened by the committee before listed as a candidate.

7. Entries must be submitted not later than **November 14, 2020 (Saturday) c/o Chapter** for chapter entries **and** to be forwarded to the ORNAP National using the email address **ornapperioperativenursesweek@gmail.com**.
8. Online Exhibit via Facebook for final entries will be posted on **November 16, 2020 (Monday) at 8:00am** and will end for the final tally of likes (**only likes and hearts will be counted**) on **November 17, 2020 (Tuesday) at 8 PM**.
9. The participant/s that will not follow the rules will be **automatically disqualified**.
10. The organization is not liable for the content of the video
11. The finalist original copies will be automatically become an official property of the ORNAP.
12. The artist will be held **accountable** to any issues that may rise with regards to originality and authenticity of the video.

Criteria:

The video presentation will be judged in terms of creativity, originality, message content and technical organization.

Creativity and originality: 30%

Entries must be original own work and related to sacrifices, innovation, collaboration, and best practices. Videos must reflect that the entries have carefully examined and thought through the topic.

Message content: 40%

Videos related to sacrifices, innovation, collaboration, best practices and it showcase the chapter's culture and festivities.

Technical organization: 15%

How well is the video produced with regards to continuity, timing, camera operation, sound quality, editing and adherence to time limit of **3- 5 minutes or (180- 300 seconds)**. **5 points** will be deducted in **every 5 seconds time exceeded**.

People's Choice- most like: 15%
